

## **Sustainable Marine Bioresources – Guidance For Final Reports**

As detailed in the grant award conditions, in addition to the standard NERC final report a more comprehensive scientific report of up to 20 pages (A4) will be required to be submitted within 3 months of the end of the project.

This report should consist of a 2 page executive summary and then a 20 page more detailed report to cover:

- the scientific objectives;
- the extent to which the objectives have been met;
- details of methods used and the results obtained, including statistical analysis (if appropriate);
- a discussion of the results and their reliability;
- the main implications of the findings;
- possible future work; and
- any action resulting from the research (e.g. IP, Knowledge Transfer).

The report should be submitted to the NERC programme contact, and will be circulated to the Programme Management Group.
